



Foster youth should get their names on the lists for Public Housing and Section 8 Housing as soon as they turn 18. Both lists are very long, sometimes even closed, and it can be months before your name will come up.

What is the difference between Public Housing & Section 8?

Public housing refers to a place that the community finds for you, in Section 8, you receive a voucher for a place YOU find in the

community.
